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1.0 PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Request for Bid (RFB) is to provide information to responsible bidders (referred throughout this RFB as "Offeror(s)" and/or "Contractor(s)"), to establish a term contract for the period of July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2023, renewable for up to (2) additional years, to provide pick up, transport and the incineration of regulated medical waste services to Eastern Virginia Medical School.

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2.0 BACKGROUND

Eastern Virginia Medical School (EVMS) was born of necessity in 1973, the result of a community-led effort to improve health care in a region then plagued with a severe shortage of physicians. Patients often had to leave the area in search of specialized care. Today, the region enjoys modern medical facilities and a full-range of medical specialties. As community leaders foresaw, EVMS was a catalyst for change, playing a key role in the region's medical renaissance through its commitment to education, research and patient care.

Education

EVMS offers a variety of graduate and doctoral degrees in the medical and health professions. Interest in all programs continues to grow. In the most recent year, EVMS received nearly 8,000 applications for 450 openings. The school now has 6,800 graduates who practice throughout Hampton Roads, across Virginia and around the globe. EVMS also provides specialty training for some 300 medical residents annually and offers Continuing Medical Education to thousands of health-care professionals practicing in the region.

Research

EVMS is the largest biomedical research institution in southeastern Virginia. More than 100 EVMS faculty members are engaged in basic and clinical research focused in areas where the community has pressing needs. Innovative research has brought EVMS to the forefront of groundbreaking discoveries — from the pioneering of in vitro fertilization in America, to the recognition of new cancer detection and treatment methods and innovative therapies for individuals suffering from the debilitating side effects of diabetes. We continually strive to enhance our research enterprise in order to improve the health of the people of Hampton Roads and beyond.

Patient Care

What once was one of the nation's most medically underserved communities is today a destination for people from around the country seeking the best available care. For the 1,500 people each day who receive high-quality, patient-centered care at more than 20 convenient EVMS Medical Group locations across the region, it equates to the best possible care, delivered with a healthy dose of compassion.

3.0 STATEMENT OF NEEDS

- Offeror shall provide disposal of medical waste for the locations listed on Attachment C.
- Offeror shall provide all equipment and materials for the packaging, labeling, marking, pick-up, loading, manifesting, transporting, treatment and disposing of regulated medical waste to include

necessary equipment.

18" x 18" x 24" boxes, red medical waste bags, lids, manifests, transport vehicles, and all

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- Offeror shall indicate if non-hazardous chemotherapeutic, and anatomical waste will be accepted and if they can be intermingled with the balance of the regulated medical waste stream.
- Offeror shall provide all collection containers and liners as part of the service at no additional cost.
- All equipment will be clearly identified/labeled/marked.
- All waste will be contained as required by the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality and the U.S. Department of Transportation (sharps in sharps containers, liquids properly contained and all waste bagged).
- Waste shall be removed from pick-up locations in a professional manner without risk of contamination to any areas of the Medical School.
- Offeror shall bear the cost of spills and re-packaging any waste at the disposal site.
- Radioactive, explosive, toxic or hazardous waste as defined by the Virginia Hazardous Waste Management Regulations will not be included.
- Pricing in Attachment C will be per box, per pick up. There will be no additional charges including freight charges, fuel charges, or any other surcharge.
- Pricing must be firm for the duration of the agreement 7/01/2020 through 6/30/2023 including any option years (7/01/2023 6/30/2024 and 7/01/2024 6/30/2025).
- Offeror shall provide a listing of all waste which will be accepted and which will not be accepted.
- The offeror shall provide on-call service in the event emergency service is required.
- Offeror shall provide EVMS with paperwork documenting the number containers removed during each pick-up.
- Title, risk of loss and all other incidents of ownership of the medical waste shall be assumed by the offeror at the time of pick-up from EVMS.
- The offeror shall be licensed with all state and federal regulations for medical waste disposal, handling, and transporting.
- Offeror shall meet US Department of Transportation regulations for waste transport
- Offeror's drivers shall comply with Department of Transportation licensing regulations. Drivers must possess valid CDL licenses with HAZMAT endorsements.
- Offeror shall possess a valid medical waste transportation registration number from the Department of Environmental Quality.
- Offeror will ensure that all required insurance are current and shall provide copies of all such licenses or insurance certificates.
- During visits to the sites, Offeror may be privy to protected and confidential information, as such must sign an EVMS HIPAA BAA.

4.0 **REQUIREMENTS:**

- List all terms and conditions including cancellation of services (EVMS' terms and conditions will govern).
- Provide information on your company's history, experience, expertise and background.
- Describe how your company ensures compliance with all Local, State and Federal laws and regulations, including all required liability insurance.

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- Offeror shall outline the step-by-step approach, process of picking up to final destination for disposal and security plan.
- Provide at least three (3) references from other clients to include company, contact name, title, phone number, email address, and how long doing business with that company.
- Describe any and all certifications/licensures and include copies of the certifications/licensures within the proposal.
- Provide a copy of your company's Certificate of Insurance (COI).
- Indicate if your company is considered a: Small Business(SB), Small Disadvantaged
 Business(SDB), Women Owned Business (WOB), HUBZone business (HUBZone), Veteran
 Owned Business (VOB), Service Disabled Veteran Owned Business (SDVOB), Minority
 Owned Business (MOB). If you identify as one of these classifications, authorized
 documentation must be provided.

5.0 PRICING SCHEDULE

Attachment C identifies the locations where services are currently provided. Offeror shall fill-in the table in Attachment C to provide the proposed cost including all applicable components.

6.0 METHOD OF PAYMENT:

- 1. The Offeror shall enroll in and acknowledges that payment will be made by payment card, also known as ePayables. Once an invoice is approved for payment, an electronic remittance advice shall be sent to the Offeror by email or facsimile, instead of a check. Payments can be retrieved with EVMS's designated account number that will be assigned to the Offeror. Terms begin after receipt of proper invoice or material/service, whichever is later.
- 2. Offeror cannot charge fees to accept ePayables.
- 3. A .5% administrative fee may be charged for check payments and default payment terms of Net 30, or others outside of ePayables.
