POLICY: EVMS Medical Group may not furnish information from the patient's medical record to his employer except in the following cases.

- 1. The patient has signed an authorization for the release of information. Refer to Authorization to Use or Disclose Protected Health Information.
 - 2. Pursuant to a valid subpoena or court order, or
 - 3. As the result of a Worker's Compensation claim.

In the case of a Worker's Compensation claim, special care should be exercised in the release of information. *Release only information related to the accident, disease or condition for which the employer or insurance company has assumed financial responsibility*. AIDS and drug and alcohol abuse information may be disclosed only if a specific release authorizing the release of such information is provided or pursuant to a court order issued after a show cause hearing as set forth in Release of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Treatment Information, and Release of AIDS (Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome) Information.
