# Open Payments Program 2018 Review Period

The 2018 Open Payments Program submission period ends on March 31, 2019. April 1, 2019 through May 15, 2019 will be the review and dispute period for physicians prior to the data being published on the CMS website in June. Physicians may dispute data through the end of the calendar year as well however it will have already been published at that point in time. As a reminder, Open Payments is a program through which direct or indirect payments/other transfers of value made to physicians are reported to CMS and published online. The purpose of this program is to provide transparency to the public about relationships between physicians and manufacturers and group purchasing organizations (GPOs).

## Anthem 25 Modifier Changes

The 25 modifier is used to denote a "significant, separately identifiable evaluation and management (E/M) service by the same physician on the same day of the procedure or other service". Anthem recently published changes to their reimbursement policy for services billed with this modifier that are currently set to take effect on April 1, 2019. The March 2019 Anthem Newsletter states that claims processed on or after this date for an E/M service billed with the 25 modifier on the same date as a "related" procedure may be denied when there is a recent service or procedure with the same or similar diagnosis on record. In a related FAQ Anthem defined "recent" as within a couple of months.

EVMS Medical Group has submitted questions for clarification on this new policy to Anthem to include what time

# e-PHI Security Tip

When searching for a patient in IDX or Allscripts, name as well as any other patient identifiers should be used to avoid accessing multiple charts, especially for patients with common names. Often when auditing we will see that a staff member accessed several different patient charts with the same name in a row. Always use MRN if available or match other identifiers to prevent these instances of inappropriate access.
