Appropriate Use of Modifier 59

Palmetto, our Medicare Contractor, recently republished an MLN article regarding Modifier 59. The 59 modifier describes a "distinct procedure service" and is used when necessary to describe services performed for various reasons on the same day as other non-E/M services. When using this modifier the documentation must show that a separate procedure, session, site or organ system, incision/excision, lesion or injury necessitated a second medically necessary service that is not normally billed alongside the initial service by the same individual on the same day. For some procedures an anatomic-specific modifier may be available. The 59 modifier should not be used in those cases. Medicare also developed additional HCPCS codes that should be used when applicable which are more specific than the 59 alone. Those codes are as follows:

- -XE: Separate encounter, distinct because it occurred during a separate encounter.
- -XS: Separate structure, distinct because it is performed on a separate organ or structure.
- -XP: Separate practitioner, distinct because it is performed by a different practitioner.
- -XU: Unusual non-overlapping service, service that doesn't typically overlap with the other.

e-PHI Security Tip

Completing all sections of the Registration form when performing an initial registration or an update assists in the collection of accurate and complete information and can prevent a breach of PHI. If outdated contact information remains in either the demographics or guarantor sections of a Registration information may be transmitted to inappropriate locations.
