Welcome and Congratulations!

YOUR BIG DAY IS ALMOST HERE! BUT FIRST...

PLEASE REMEMBER:

Plan to arrive no later than

8:30 a.m.

on Saturday morning.

Arrival

- Doors open for graduates at 8:00 a.m.
- Allow time for traffic, road closures, tunnel delays, inclement weather, and security screenings upon entry
- Arrive wearing your regalia or bring your regalia in ready to wear condition

Parking

- Parking - \$5 **cash** upon entry
 - Scope underground garage
 - Surface lot across St. Paul's Blvd.
- The Scope Parking Garage contains accessible parking spaces adjacent to the Scope Arena lower Box Office doors.

Entry

- Enter through the Exhibition Hall doors in the underground garage closest to the parking entry gate
- After Security Check - proceed to iPad check-in and then to your program table
- Leave personal belongings in car or with family members.
 - Do not bring any other items with you (no purses, books, etc.)
 - Items you can't leave behind such as car keys and phones can be secured with Police & Public Safety in Meeting Room 3

Family and Guests

- Doors open on the Plaza Level at 8:45 a.m. for family and friends; please note they are not permitted in the Exhibition Hall
- Balloons are not permitted inside the Scope
- Guests may bring sealed, unopened bottles of water. Other outside food and beverage items are not permitted.

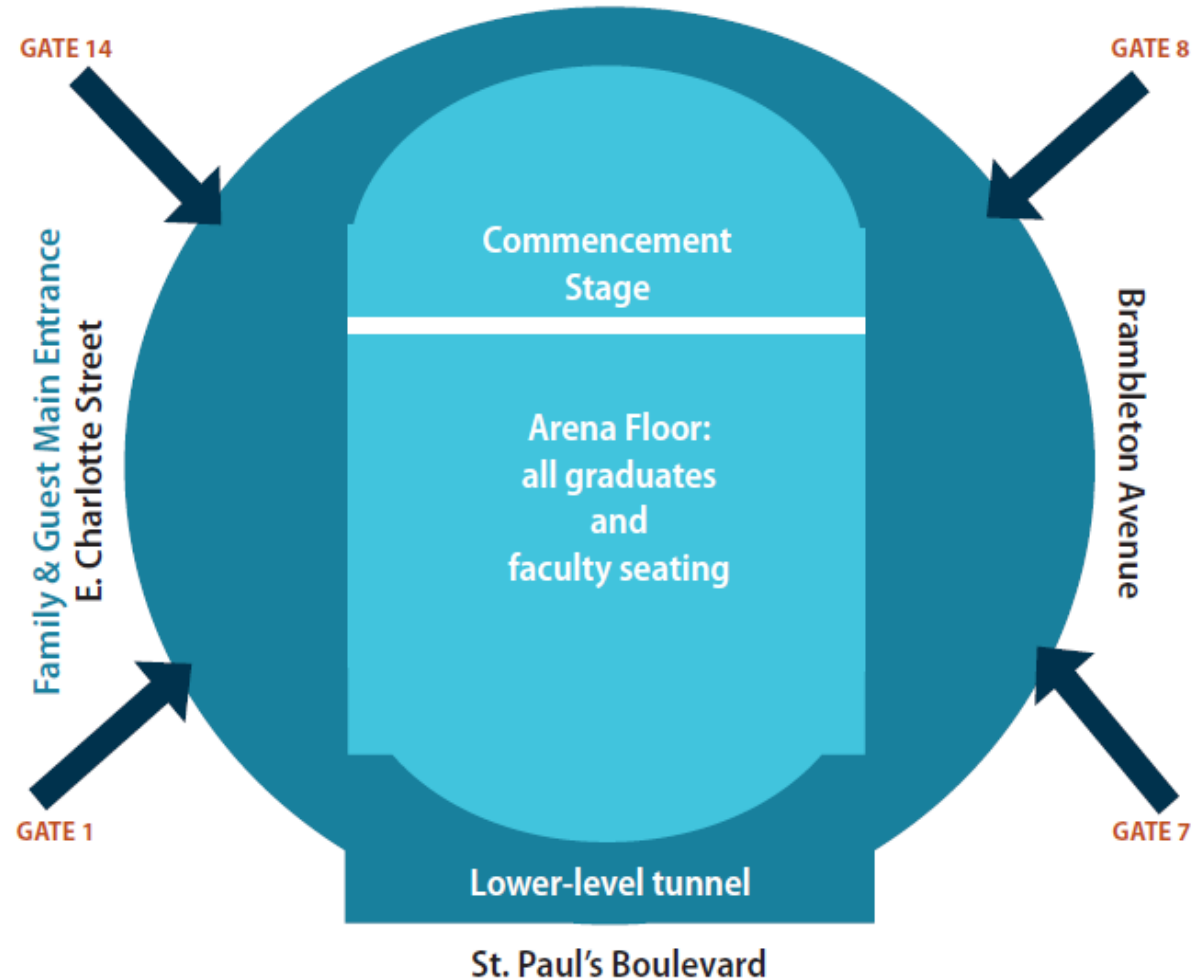

COVID-19 Protocol

- Vaccinations and masks are not required to attend or participate in EVMS Commencement
- EVMS supports individuals who prefer to wear a mask in the ceremony or arena
- Please be sure to share this information with your family and friends
 - A live stream will be available on the EVMS.edu homepage for guests who are unable to attend in person

Attire

- **Professional attire is required.** Individuals who are not dressed appropriately will not be allowed to participate.
- **All participants must wear**
 - **either pants, a dress or skirt.** Shorts and jeans are not permitted.
 - **dark, low-heeled footwear is recommended.** Athletic footwear and flip flops are not permitted.
- No jewelry can be worn on or over your regalia.
- **Men wearing a collared shirt are required to wear a tie.**
- Men are requested to remove their mortarboard or tam for the national anthem.

Regalia

- **DON'T FORGET YOUR REGALIA!**
 - Be sure to take your regalia out of the package before coming to Commencement.
 - Steam or hang your regalia to relax any wrinkles. If using an iron, use a low heat setting and do **not** use on the velvet.
 - Double check that you have all components of your regalia – gown, hood, mortarboard or tam, and tassel
- Wear comfortable shoes that won't slip off

Regalia

- **Masters Graduates:**
 - Wear gown, hood and honor cords/stoles
 - Bring cap with tassel
- **Doctoral Graduates:**
 - Wear gown and honor cords
 - Bring hood and tam with tassel

Academic Honors

- You will pick up AOA and GHHS Honor Cords and Military Service Cords at your program table.
- Any honor cords or stoles issued prior to Commencement day are your responsibility to bring.
- Only cords and stoles issued by EVMS are permitted to be worn during the ceremony.

Amenities & Accommodations

- Personal belongings such as car keys and phones can be secured with Police & Public Safety.
- Bobby pins are available at program tables and in restrooms to secure your caps/tams.
- A lactation room is available for nursing mothers.
- If you requested or need other accommodations, ask a staff member to help you onsite.

Name Pronunciation

- You will receive your reader card at your program table.
- Review your reader card once for misspellings or other inaccuracies.
 - The name on your reader card is the one you provided in your application to graduate and cannot be changed.
- Linguists have reviewed the name pronunciations you provided.
- If the Linguist has requested to see you prior to the ceremony, you will be notified at your program table. If so, please go directly to them after you check in.
- Do NOT write on your reader cards.

Processional

- Go to the restroom BEFORE lining up for the processional. The ceremony can last up to 3 hours!
- **Masters Graduates:**
 - Only carry your reader cards
- **Doctoral Graduates:**
 - Only carry your reader cards and hoods (over your left arm)

Processional

- We will seat the right side of the arena followed by the left side.
- Quickly march two-by-two; then enter the row indicated by the usher.
- The first student processing in each program will give program card to row usher.

Processional

- Graduates process in first, followed by faculty and then Platform Party.
- Remain standing in front of your chair until you are asked to be seated.
- You will be seated with your programs in the following format:

Conferral of Degrees

- During the ceremony, Dr. Combs or Dr. Flenner will call for each School to stand collectively.
- He will state that the academic requirements have been met.
- The President will confer the degree.

Lining Up to the Cross Stage

- An usher will call your row and direct you towards the stage.
- **Don't forget your reader card!**
- **Doctoral Graduates:**
 - Hood folded over your left arm – make sure it is unbuttoned

Crossing the Stage

- Your reader card will be scanned before reaching the stairs.
- Once directed, climb the stairs and hand the card to the linguist who will read your name.
- Walk as soon as you hand off your card; **DO NOT WAIT** for your name to be called.

Crossing the Stage

- Awards and distinctions (if any) will appear on the Jumbotron as you cross the stage.
- You will receive your diploma cover as you cross stage.
- Shaking hands is permitted.

Crossing the Stage

Doctoral Graduates hooded on stage:

- Ascend stairs and hand reader cards to reader.
- Give hood to the hooding assistants.
- Turn and face the audience.
- Men, remove your caps. Women do not.
- Please stoop down if you are very tall.

GradImages

- Individual photos of graduates receiving diplomas and being hooded, as well as posed portraits after exiting the stage, will be taken by a professional photographer.
- It is important to keep the photography line running smoothly, **do not stop** on the stage or stairs to pose for photos for friends or family.

GradImages

- Photos are available for purchase and a link will be emailed to you within 1 week of graduation to the non-EVMS email address you provided during registration.
- Photos will also be available at gradimages.com.
- Additional photos taken by EVMS will be posted on EVMS Flickr site.

Confetti Wands

- At the end of ceremony, the Chief Marshal will ask graduates to rise. At this time, retrieve confetti wands from under your seats.
- When audience is asked to congratulate the graduates and alumni, applause and music will begin. Release confetti wands at this time – NOT BEFORE.
- Please direct the confetti wand **up**, not forward.

Recessional

- Following, the recessional occurs in the following order:
 - Platform Party
 - Faculty
 - Last rows on both sides of arena floor begin first; an usher will direct you.
- Move more quickly. Spacing is not important.

Post Ceremony

- Collect personal items stored with EVMS Police.
- Graduates who did not pick up their class pins/gift earlier in the week proceed to the Alumni table.
- Return any borrowed regalia items to the regalia table. Otherwise, regalia and any honor cords you received are yours to keep.
- Exit the Exhibition Hall and head up to the outdoor plaza to meet your family and friends.

Diplomas

- Diploma certificates are not in the covers you receive on stage.
- 2023 Graduates *who have completed degree requirements* will be mailed diplomas by the end of June to the address provided in your graduation application.
