
Q1 Have you ever raised a work-related safety concern?







Q4 If yes, how positive was your experience during this interaction?





Q6 I am aware of the ways that I can report incidents, hazards, or near misses.



Q7 The safety training I receive at work helps me stay safe on my job.







Q10 My work unit is involved in the campus safety programs focused on my safety.



Q11 My department or work unit has taken steps over the last 12 months to make my work place safe.









Q19 Identify your type of employment



Q20 How many years have you worked for this institution?



Q21 Do you supervise employees?



Q22 Have you ever experienced an accident and/or injury while working at this institution?


