POLICY ON FACULTY EVALUATION 2015

The Program Director is responsible for ensuring the guality of the educational experiences of the training program. Faculty evaluations will be conducted related to teaching and scholarly activity of the faculty members. Scholarly activity will be reviewed under the four categories defined by the ACGME: Scholarship of Discovery, Scholarship of Dissemination, Scholarship of Application and Scholarship of Participation. Faculty evaluations will be formally conducted on an annual basis; however, issues which arise between these annual reviews shall be addressed within a reasonable time period. Trainees will provided confidential evaluations of their supervising faculty members and those providing didactic or other conference offerings. Anonymity and confidentially are provided to the responder through the use of an electronic evaluation system (or describe the system and how the evaluations are summarized). The Program Director will present any continued problems to the Residency Education Committee. The Department Chairman and the Program Director have the authority to dismiss a faculty member from their teaching responsibilities if they are not meeting their The Program Director will provide summaries of the Faculty Evaluations to the obligation. Departmental Chair for use in his/her faculty evaluation process.

Each year the Otolaryngology residents review faculty performance in a confidential fashion. The results of these faculty evaluations are consolidated by the residency program director who distributes the results to the individual faculty member for their review. The Department Chairman also receives these reviews and utilizes this input during his annual faculty review with the individual faculty member. Each month, the department meets for a full-time faculty meeting during which a separate segment for resident educational program items are discussed. In this open forum any items pertaining to resident education and faculty performance are entertained by the Department Chairman from the full-time faculty and residency program director.
